Russell Silverton Wider Parish Re-Opening Protocol

Please remember that there is no safe re-opening policy that will protect you 100%.

You will need to make your own decision about attending based on the information provided below.

Current government regulations limit the number of people in the building at 50% of maximum capacity.

- If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, we ask that you please stay home.
- At Knox, on Sunday morning please use the main entrance unless you require the elevator.
- It is highly recommended that all those entering the building be double vaccinated, although we will not be requiring proof.
- Masks are to be worn at all times while in the building.
- Social distancing policies require that you keep a distance of 6 feet between household groups.
- All those who enter the building will be required to use the hand sanitizer provided at the entrance.
- You will be asked to provide your contact information upon entrance to the building.
- In lieu of passing a collection plate during the service, you may drop your collection on the plate at the back of the church upon entry.
- An usher will help identify appropriate seating for you and your family.
- Singing has been identified as a high risk activity, so at this time we ask that you refrain from singing. There will be a designated singer and we encourage you to quietly hum or clap along.
- Ushers will be there to assist you with leaving the building in order to respect social distancing.
- Safe Communion guidelines are being developed so that once again we will be able to share the body of Christ.
- Covid-19 Cleaning protocols and guidelines will be observed.
